Treasurer's Report:

Currently we have \$2750 in the treasury. Anticipated expenses: insurance (approx. \$325) and Judith Card final website bill (\$325).

Camp Burton Update:

Nearly 75 registrants! Dance space will need to be expanded from initial estimate. Paypal payment option is on website but website wasn't up this summer, so only two people have paid via Paypal (which charges high fees). Next year we will ask for additional Paypal fee if used for registrations.

Leadership: 5 sessions are planned, with a 3-person team for each session. All know they might need to fit in an additional guest leader. Lots of enthusiasm. No after-lunch session until 4:00, but there are requests to offer workshops in early afternoon. Saturday night is zikr, with jam following. Nuria-Mubeen will be musician boshi. One of Matin's monitors may be available if it can be transported for one zoom (Saturday morning) hybrid session.

Decorating: John has hangings, as does Hassan. Elizabeth is leading the decorating team.

Outdoor dances:
